Dear Premier

I write to advise that the following Motion was passed unanimously by over 300 people attending a public meeting (with over 500 people also attending on line) at the Hobart Town Hall on 25 February 2025:

This meeting calls on the Tasmanian Government to:

(a) immediately abandon its Macquarie Point Stadium proposal before any more public monies are wasted on this unachievable project; and

(b) renegotiate the Team Agreement with the AFL to deliver AFL and AFLW teams while reclaiming the State's sovereignty over decisions regarding where and when AFL/AFLW sporting facilities are to be built or upgraded.

Given the predictions of Mr Eslake and Dr Gruen as to the State's disastrous budget position have crystallised, the damage caused by your stadium proposal is no longer arguable. Opinion polls show the population is largely opposed to your stadium, and the figures will not improve for you given the increasing cutbacks and debt.
